

WATSON, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate on the Southwest side of Somerset Avenue (formerly East King Street), being known and designated as lots #76 and #77, Anderson Street Highlands, as per plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book J, Page 157, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Somerset Avenue at joint corner of Lot #77 and #78, said pin being 200 feet northwest of the iron pin in the southwest corner of the intersection of Somerset Avenue with Hodges Street; thence S. 42-40 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-20 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots #75 and #76; thence N. 42-40 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Somerset Avenue; thence along Somerset Avenue S. 47-20 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
