Donahoo, Surveyor, October 27th 1947; the four roads having the following names and designations: Road No. 1, named the Hammett Road which leaves to old Chick Springs Road at or near the Hammett, W.A. home place and runs in a northwesterly direction across an open field and crossing the Piedmont & Northern Railroad, then crossing another open field and intersects a road that is shown on the B. F. Flynn Estate Subdivision and entering the Super Highway a short distance west from the Star Oil Company. The said road is to be not less than 36 feet in width. Road No. 2, named Valley Road, which leaves the Old U. S. Highway No. 29, a short distance south from the intersection of the said Old Highway with the Super Highway, and runs a general southern direction to the line of other property of Mrs. M. E. Hunt, now Mrs. M. E. Hunt. This road is to be not less than 36 feet in width. Road No. 3, named Carl street, which leaves the Valley Road at the line of property of Fred Hunt and runs in an easterly direction until it intersects the Hammett Road (Road No. 1) at a point which will appear hereafter on the plat of which will appear hereafter on the plat of
