acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. L. Loftis

his heirs and assigns, all of my right  
 title, interest and estate, either legal  
 or Equitable, of, in, or to, all of that piece  
 parcel or tract of land situated, lying and  
 being, in the State and County aforesaid,  
 on the status of Mountain Creek, con-  
 taining ten (10) Acres more or less;  
 being a portion of a tract of land  
 owned by my husband, Stephen March-  
 bantes, during his life time, and  
 after his marriage to me; and which  
 he sold to James B. Rosemond in  
 1839, and in which I never  
 relinqushed my Dower; It being  
 my intention now to convey to the  
 said W. L. Loftis, by this Deed, my Dower  
 right, in that portion of the said  
 Rosemond tract now owned by  
 him, and conveyed to him by and  
 of Mary E. Kendrick, Nancy A. Rus-  
 sell, M. A. Allen, and E. M. Martin
