I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Ollie R. Barsh, Individually and as Administratrix of the  
Estate of J. Edward Barsh, deceased

on or about the 11th day of May in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-nine exhibited her  
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against  
Elaine Joann Barsh, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the 25th day of August 1949,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Ollie Ridgeway Barsh  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said Ollie Ridgeway Barsh, her heirs and assigns, an undivided one-  
third interest possessed by the said Elaine Joann Barsh, Charles Richard  
Barsh and Sandra Caroline Barsh, said 1/3 interest being all of the  
interest of said minors, in and to all those two tracts of land more  
fully described as follows, to-wit:

FIRST: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State and County  
aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 6  
Block B of the O. P. Mills property as shown on a plat recorded in the  
RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", page 284, and having  
set metes and bounds as are shown on said plat; said lot having a frontage  
on Ladson Street of 56 3/10 feet. The back line being 40 8/10 feet and  
the depth of said lot being 173 feet, more or less. This being the same  
land conveyed to J. Edward Barsh and Ollie R. Barsh by deed recorded in  
the aforesaid RMC Office in Rol 264, at page 391.

SECOND: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State and County  
aforesaid, in Grove Township, being known and designated as lot Nos. 14
