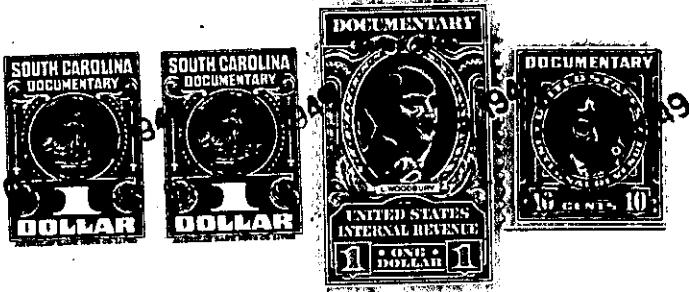

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of Courtland Drive, the joint front corner of lots Nos. 17 and 18, said beginning point being 1505.6 feet from the northwestern intersection of Courtland Drive and Sulpher Springs Road and running thence with the joint line of lots Nos. 17 and 18, N. 84-30 W. 781.1 feet to a point in the eastern line of lot No. 26; thence with the eastern line of lot No. 26 and the rear line of lot No. 17, N. 6-47 W. 204.7 feet to a point in the southern line of lot No. 16; thence with the joint line of lots Nos. 16 and 17, S. 84-30 E. 824.7 feet to a point on the western side of Courtland Drive, the joint front corner of lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence with the western side of Courtland Drive S. 5-30 W. 200 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.68 acres.
