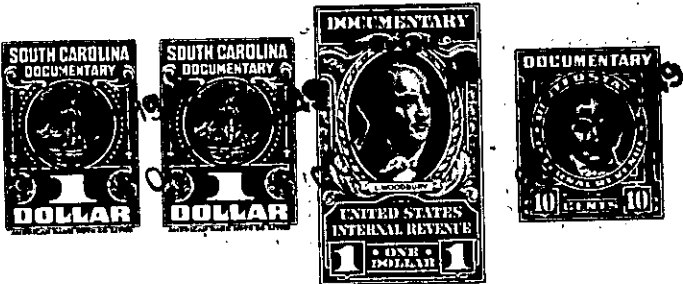

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack J. Campbell, his heirs and assigns forever.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 22, according to plat of property of the Perry Estate, recorded in Flat Book "B", page 33, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, according to Survey and Plat by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated December 1946:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southeast side of Brockman Avenue, front corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23; thence with line of said Lots S. 50-33 E. 111.2 to a stake, thence with line of Lot # 17, S. 49-20 W. 60.7 feet to a stake; thence with line of lot #21, N.50-33 W. 115.8 feet to a stake on said Avenue; thence with said Avenue N. 53-30 E. 61.7 feet to the beginning.

The within conveyance is subject to a reservation of a five (5) foot strip across the rear portion of said property in said deed of Albert W. Nichy to Matella C. Ham.

As a part of the consideration for the within conveyance, the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the outstanding balance in the total amount of \$6,157.67 due as of August 23rd 1949, on those two certain mortgages executed by Albert W.
