to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. T. Bates, all my right, title and interest in and to the following described property. The same being the entire estate of A. J. and Kezziah Batson Bates and consisting of two tracts.

I. "All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 250 acres, more or less, adjoining lands of J. F. Bates, Lawrence Ashworth, C. C. Bates, W. T. Newby and others, and known as the home place of A. J. Bates, deceased."

II. "All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 255 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to A. J. Bates by H. C. Beatvie by deed dated July 19, 1904, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. LLL at page 604.

It being our intention by this deed to convey to the grantee hereinabove named all of our interest in all the real estate of which the said A. J. Bates and Kezziah Batson Bates died seized and possessed, less any part or tract sold by the heirs or distributees of the said A. J. Bates and Kezziah Batson Bates prior to the making of this instrument, whether the same is described herein or not.
