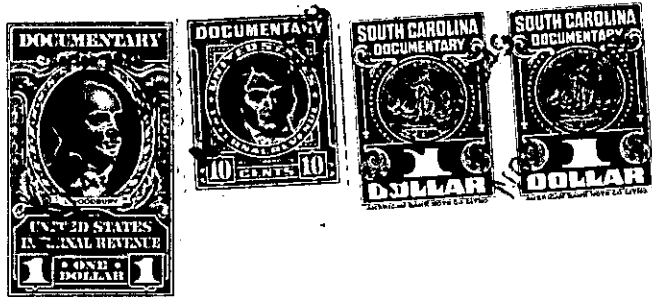

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Virginia C. Taylor and Horace L. Taylor, their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive and known and designated a Lot No. 91 of Map No. 2 of Cammilla Park, a Plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 85, and having, according to said Plat the following metes and bounds and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive, which iron pin is 420 feet from the Northeastern intersection of Welcome Avenue and Blythewood Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 90 and 91, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 69-24 E., 243.2 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 6-42 W., 83.3 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 91 and 92; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 74 W., 257.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Blythewood Drive; thence along the Eastern side of Blythewood Drive, S. 16-34 E., 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
