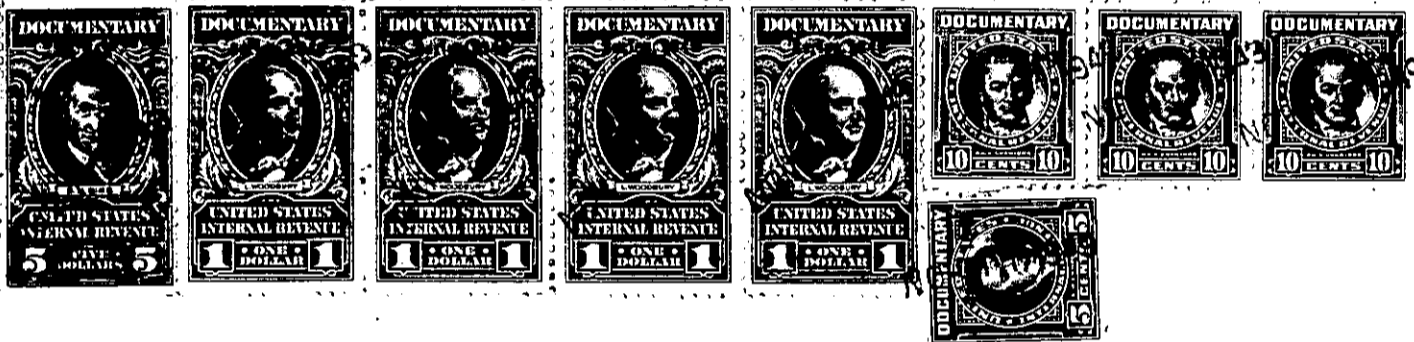
I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:
