

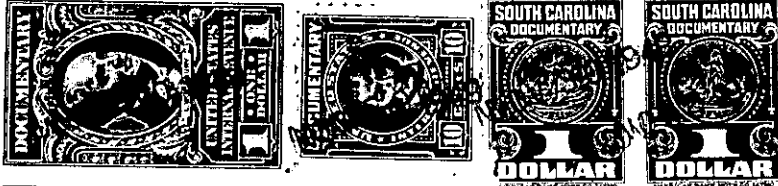

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Saluda** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at East corner of J. L. Nichols' property on North side of Johnson and Greenwood Road; thence along said road North 55, West 500 feet, North 31½ West ^{400 ft} along said road; thence North 45 West 300 feet along said road; thence North 55 West 400 along said road to land of C. L. Greenwood; thence due North along Greenwood land 310 feet to a big rock; thence 45 East 614 feet along said Greenwood lands to rock; thence North 72½ East 430 feet along Greenwood lands to a rock; thence South 35 East 1085 ft. to a stake on land of J. L. Nichols estate; thence South 66 West 500 feet along Nichols land to a pine tree; thence South 14 East 900 feet along said Nichols estate to beginning corner, containing 35 and 13/100 (35.13) acres, more or less.
