GREENVILLE CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

DEC 28 9 20 AM 1949

WHEREAS,

T. LESENE WILSON of Charleston, S. C.

and

WILLIAM E. CHANDLER, JR. of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 21st day of December, 1949, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is SOUTH CAROLINA SOFT DRINK BOTTLERS SELF INSURANCE SERVICE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to provide managerial and technical services required by soft drink bottlers operating as self-insurers under provisions of the South Carolina Workmen's Compensation Act.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of One (\$1.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 2nd day of December, 1949, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

T. Lesene Wilson and William E. Chandler, Jr.

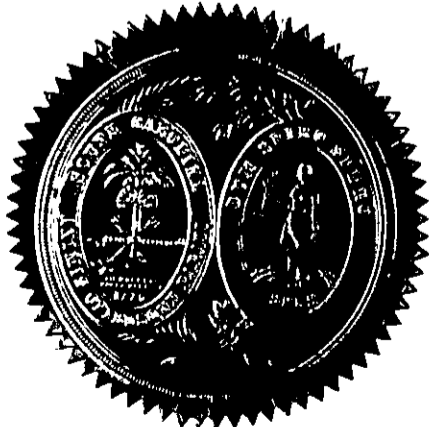
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, T. Lesene Wilson; as Vice-President, ; as Secretary, William E. Chandler, Jr.; as Treasurer, William E. Chandler, Jr..

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, P. T. BRADHAM, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 21st day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and in the one hundred and seventy-fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
