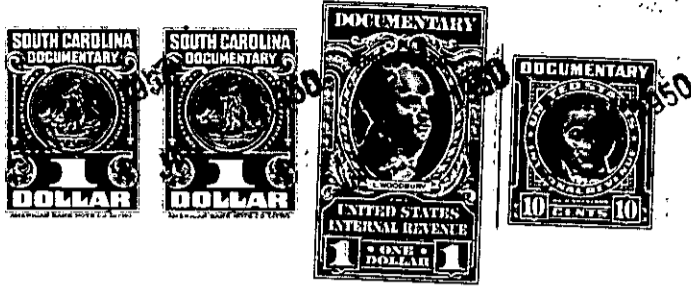

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina known as the land conveyed to me
by R. L. Greene, and adjoins the lands of R. L.
Greene & Perry Batson's heirs, and beginning
on a stone S. W. corner, thence running
N. ~~27~~ 27 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 4.95 chains to an iron
pin on road above the Perry Batson old
home place; thence north 61 E 6.05 chains
to an iron pin; thence S 27 $\frac{3}{4}$ E 4.95
to an iron pin; thence S. 61 W 6.08
