

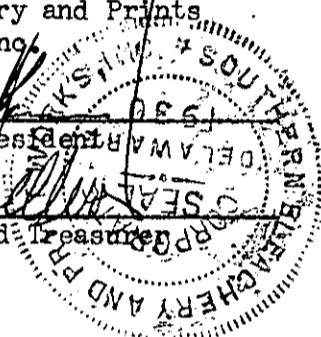
And, in case the said land shall cease to be used by the American Legion Post No. 137 for its local purposes, then the same shall revert to the Grantor, its successors and assigns.

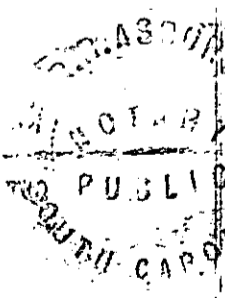
