That I, Noland Meyers, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS.

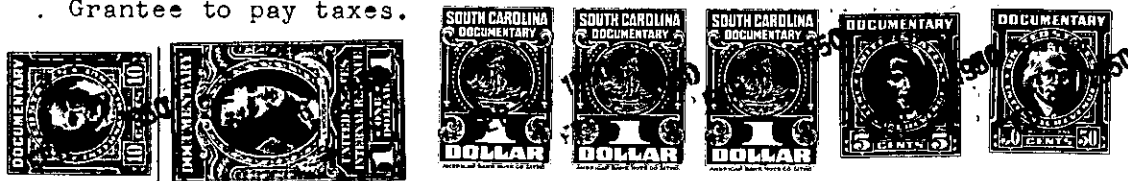

L. A. Nelson and S. D. Brown, their heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about three miles from Greenville Courthouse, being known and designated as Lots No. 51 and 52 of Sunset Hills, according to a plat thereof, made by R. E. Dalton, dated December, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P. at Page 19 and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Seminole Drive corner of Lot No. 50 and running thence along line of said lot N. 48-50 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-10 E. 177.3 feet to an iron in line of J. R. Jenkinson Estate; thence along line of said estate S. 55-50 W. 176.15 feet, to Seminole Drive; thence along said Drive N. 41-10 W. 157.3 feet to the point of beginning.

SAID Property is subject to the restrictions or protective covenants contained in the instrument executed by Noland Meyers, dated March 6, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, Book of Deeds 288, a Page 204, as fully and completely as though said restrictions or protective covenants were fully and completely set forth in this deed.
