A one-half undivided interest in and to two tracts
~~all that piece or parcel~~ of land in Highland Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina in the Tigerville Community being portions of the
land formerly owned by J. H. Roe, now deceased, and likewise being por-
tions of the lands conveyed to J. C. Roe by J. H. Roe by deed dated
October 15, 1945 and recorded in Book 281, page 391, and being the
identical lands conveyed to H. F. Goodlett by J. C. Roe by deed dated
January 6, 1950.

One of the tracts contains 152.5 acres according to a survey made
by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, under date of December 6, 1949, is on the
Marietta-Tigerville-Highland Road and Meadow Fork Creek, and is fully
set forth by courses and distances and metes and bounds on the H. S.
Brockman plat which is recorded in the office of R. M. C., Greenville

The other tract contains 30.6 acres according to a plat thereof
made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, in December, 1949, is located on the
south fork of Tiger River, and is bounded by lands of Ruthel Prince,
