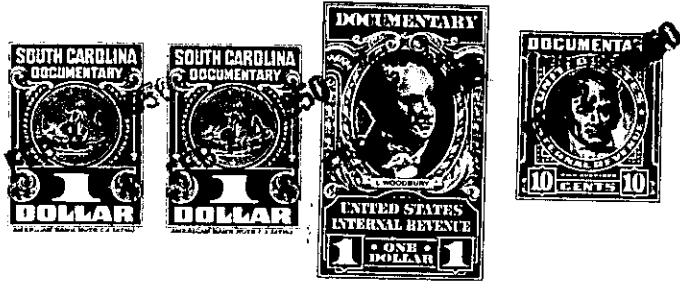

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six hundred

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Henry L. Sullivan and Essie H. Sullivan
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry L. Sullivan and Essie H. Sullivan

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville city Township Greenville
County, State of South Carolina

Beginning at a point on Arden St. Extension, which point is
N. 55-45E. 140 feet from the North East corner of Arden St.
Extension and Richoltown Road., and running thence N. 50-04E. 159.5
feet; thence N. 55-45E. 50.4 feet; thence S. 00-57E. 158.3 feet;
thence S. 55-45W. 40 feet to the beginning. This being lot #7 as
shown on a plat of Richoltown #4 which plat is recorded in Plat
Book L. Pg. 159 in the office of the R.M.C. Greenville County S.C.
