Mountain, and having the following retes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the west side of the Altamont Road,
corner of property now or formerly owned by Mrs. F.J.P. Cogswell, and running
thence approximately S. 25-15 E. 332.7 feet to a point on the west side of
said road; thence in a southwesternly direction to a stone in corner of
property now or formerly owned by W. T. Thomson; thence with said Thomson line,
S. 63-30 W. 386 feet to a corner; thence N. 22-00 W. 632 feet to corner of

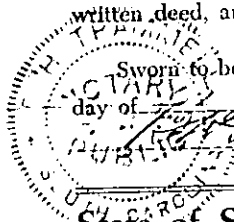
