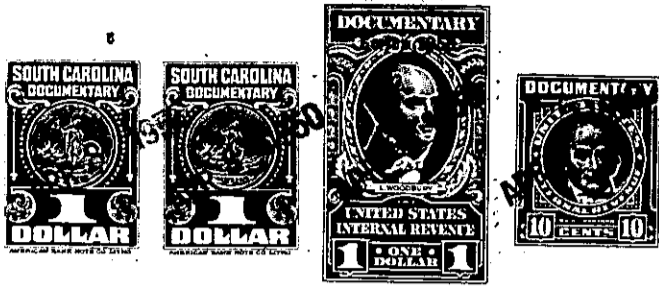

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. G. Serrine

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and no/100-----
----- Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Mary Plumer and Lizzie Cummings
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Plumer and Lizzie Cummings,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the north side
of Sullivan Street as shown on plat as lot No. 3, made by Dalton
& Neves, September 10, 1947, said plat recorded in Plat Book R,
page 89, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Sullivan Street
at the corner of lot No. 4 and running thence along the line of
lot No. 4, N. 18-60 E. 106.3 feet to lot No. 2; thence along the
line of lot No. 2, S. 69-00 E. 36.1 feet to corner of the lot
now or formerly belonging to Hunter; thence along the Hunter
line, S. 15-03 W. 109 feet to Sullivan Street; thence along said
Street, N. 67-12 W. 43.4 feet to the beginning corner. This
lot lies west of Trotter Street.

While the above metes and bounds do not correspond with
the description in deed recorded in Deed Book 5, page 452, it is,
nevertheless, the same land conveyed to E. D. Goldsmith by said
deed.
