Know All Men by These Presents:

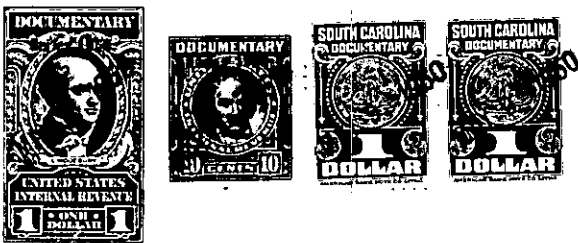
That I, C. F. Putman in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (\$800.00)

\*All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, which are known and designated as Lots 11 and 12 on a plat of the property of L. T. Jones, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in May, 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "U", at Page 145, located on Jones Circle, and, according to said plat, being described as follows:

BEGINNING on Jones Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11 and running thence N. 27-50 W., 474 feet to joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence N. 55-37 E., 139.3 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence with line of Lots Nos. 12 and 13, S. 30-18 E., 465.4 feet to Jones Circle; thence with Jones Circle, S. 53-30 W., 160 feet to the beginning corner.
