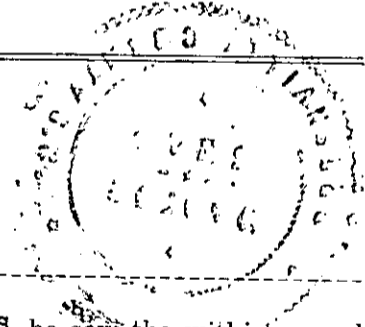
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said A. H. Ayers, his heirs and assigns forever.
