 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these
 Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Long Realty Company, Incorporated,

its Successors and Assigns, forever, the following described property:

All and singular, all that certain tract of land situate,
 lying and being in Gantt Township, County of Greenville,
 State of South Carolina, being located near Gantt Station,
 and being approximately six (6) miles from the City of
 Greenville, and being Tract No. One (1) and a portion of
 Tract No. Two (2), according to a plat of the W. M. Meyers
 Estate made by B. F. Wigginton on December 12, 1932, and
 being recorded in Plat Book H, at page 217, and which will
 more fully appear from survey thereof made by Pickell &
 Pickell on February 18, 1950, which said plat is attached
 hereto. The said tract has a total acreage of Ten and Forty-
 Six One Hundredths (10.46) acres and lies at the intersection
 of the Old Grove Road with the railroad spur track leading
 to the Greenville Air Base, as will more fully appear by
