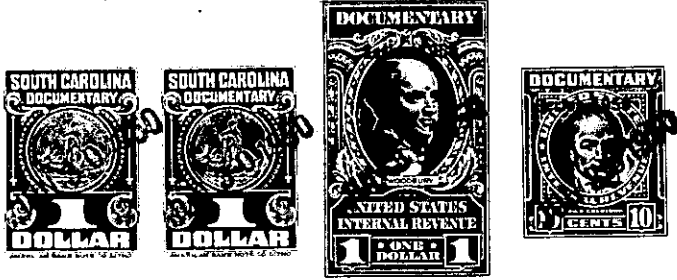

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina lying and situated in Grove Station School
District, between Piedmont and Northern Railway and Highway number
Twenty Nine, having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at corner of lot number 5 on highway 29, thence S-65-48-E-
183.4 feet to iron pin, joint corners of lots # 4 and 5, thence
S-27-52-W 66.1 feet to iron pin corner, corner lot # 3 joint #3-#4,
thence N-58-15-W 186.1 feet to iron pin on Highway # 29, thence a-
long said Highway # 29 N-31-45-E 90 feet to beginning corner, and
