all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the South side of Dual-lane Highway No. 29 between Greer and Chick Springs, indicated as Lot No. 44 on a plat of the lands of the W.E. Dill Estate by S.C. Moon, Surveyor, dated April, 1940, but having courses and distances correctly measured as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the right-of-way line of the said Highway, corner of Lot No. 45, and running thence along the right-of-way line, N. 67.10 E. 105 feet to corner of Lot No. 43; thence S. 21.40 E. 204 feet to iron pin; thence S. 67.25 W. 130 feet to iron pin; thence N. 14.40 W. 204 feet to the beginning corner.
