and Edgar C. Waldrop Estate in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and No/100- - -(\$500.00)- - - DOLLARS,

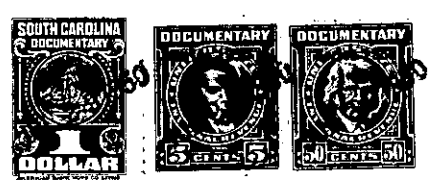

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Dover Street, near the City of Greenville and being shown as lot No. 60, on plat of property of Edgar C. Waldrop, made by Dalton & Neves in March 1946, recorded in Plat Book B at Page 171, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Dover Street, 41.1 feet South from Fair Street at corner of lot No. 61, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 86-04 E. 150 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 39; thence with the line of said lot, S. 3-56 E. 50 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 59; thence with the line of said lot, S. 86-04 W. 150 feet to a stake on Dover Street; thence with the Eastern side of Dover Street, N. 3-56 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Edgar C. Waldrop, as Trustee, by Freddie M. Herlong by deed dated February 19, 1946, recorded in Book of Deeds 287 at Page 224; James L. Love was duly substituted as Trustee by a Decree of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County.
