County and state aforesaid, about Twelve miles north of Greenville C.H.  
and on the North side of the Bumcomb Road, and on waters of Enoree River  
and containing Fifty Nine Acres be the same more or less, my interest  
being one half, and being the same tract of land conveyed to W.G. Bowers and  
W.E. Hart By Fannie E. Thompson, by deed bearing date the 24 th, day of  
August 1911, and recorded in the R.M.C. office at Greenville S.C. in  
Vol, 10 Page 344, and bounded by lands of Charley Poolle, Estate of  
S.S. Crittenden, Henry Gibson, and others, and having the following metes  
and bounds to Witt, Beginning on a White Oak, 3 X. O.M. Stone 3 X N.
