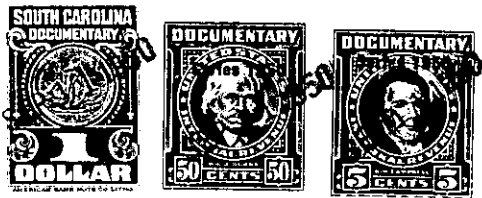

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina containing two (2) acres, more or less.

adjoining lands of myself, J. R. Bishop, J. M. Brock and possibly others.

Having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a stake at corner of Mrs. Pearl M. Osteen and running thence South 68 1/2 West, 404.5 feet to a stake; thence North 49 West, 257.4 feet to corner in old road; thence North 42 West, 205 feet to corner in br nch near spring at line of Mrs. E. A. Cason; thence along line of Mrs. E.A. Cason North 73-3/4 East, to corner of J.R.Bishop; thence along line of J.R.Bishop South 10 1/2 East, 86 feet to a stake; thence South 23 1/2 East, 110 feet to a stake; thence South 63-3/4 East, 66 feet to a stake; thence South 83 East, 188 feet to a stake, new corner; thence Southerly to beginning corner.

Provided further that said grantees shall have a driveway fifteen feet wide (15) extending along line of J. R. Bishop to public road leading to Highway No. 29.
