hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto George M.  
Williamson and Bernice Williamson, their Heirs and Assigns forever,  
all of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated  
as lot No. 62 on a Plat of Augusta Acres, property of Marsmen, Inc.,  
recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "S",  
page 201, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Meadors Avenue,  
joint corner of lots Nos. 62 and 63, and running thence  
with line of lot No. 63, N. 69-42 E, 200 feet to an iron  
pin; thence with rear line of lot No. 68, N. 20-18 W., 100  
feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 61 and 62;
