DECREE

Now came the plaintiff, and the defendant having been duly served with summons and a copy of the petition herein; or having been legally summoned by publication; and having failed to appear, the Court finds.....

Benjamin F. Ross in default for answer and demurrer to said petition, and finds that the allegations thereof are confessed by The Defendant to be true. The Court also finds that the plaintiff, at the time of filing her petition, had been a resident of the State of Ohio for one year next preceding the same, and was at that time a bona fide resident of Franklin County, and had resided in Franklin County more than 30 days immediately preceding the filing of her petition, and that the parties hereto were married, as in said petition set forth. The Court further finds, upon the evidence adduced that the Defendant has been guilty of

Gross Neglect of Duty

and that by reason thereof the Plaintiff is entitled to a divorce as prayed for in her petition; ~~or answer and cross-petition~~ It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court, that the marriage contract heretofore existing between the said Rosie Lee Ross and Benjamin F. Ross be, and the same hereby is dissolved and both parties are released from the obligations of the same.

It is further ordered that the said pay the costs herein taxed \$..... within five days, or execution be issued therefor.
