to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Caroline L. Lawton, her heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Northwest side of Oakview Drive in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots # 5 and 6 on a certain plat of property of Harold C. Gibson, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "X" at page 73, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Oakview Drive at the joint corner of Lots # 4 and 5, and running thence N. 68-37 W. 160.0 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots # 4 and 5; thence S. 21-23 W. 85.7 feet to the North side of a public alley; thence along said alley S. 69-56 E. 5.2 feet; thence still along said alley S. 37-48 E. 160.2 feet to the intersection with said Oakview Drive; thence along said Oakview Drive N. 82.01 E. 19.75 feet; thence still along Oakview Drive N. 21-23 E. 157.3 feet to the point of beginning, being all of Lots # 5 and 6 as shown on the plat hereinabove described.

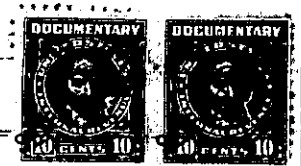
