KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Myrtle S. Holliday of Greenville County

in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00)

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these

presents by Robert B. Holliday

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert B. Holliday, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about six miles Northeast of the Town of Belton, on Highway No. 247, containing two thirds of (2/3) an acre, more or less, having the following metes and bounds , as shown by a plat made by T. J. Leslie, Reg Surveyor, dated September 19th 1950, Beginning at a corner in the center of Highway No. 247, and running N8-15W two hundred eighty nine and three tenths (289.3) feet to corner, thence S60-35E two hundred fifty (250) feet to corner in center of said Highway, thence along said highway two hundred forty five and five tenths (245.5) feet to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of the said Mrs. Myrtle S. Holliday, Highway No. 247 and other lands of Robert B. Holliday.
