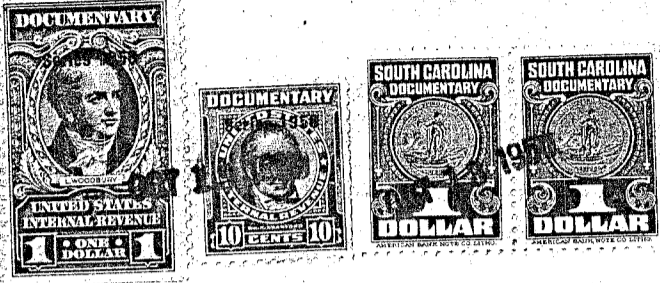

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina near the village of Travelers Rest containing seventy seven one hundredths acre and having the following metes and bounds:
