KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That City of Greenville, S. C.,

a/corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at  
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration  
of the sum of One & No/100 (\$1.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee  
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell/<sup>quitclaim</sup>and release unto Janie G. Derieux  
and Elizabeth Gilreath, As Executrixces of the Estate of J. D. Gilreath, Deceased, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, within Ward 2 of the City of Greenville and within the area known as Springwood Cemetery in Ward 2 of said City and being known and designated as Lot No. 114 on a revised map of Springwood Cemetery prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers under date of October 1, 1925.

This is a quitclaim deed by the City of Greenville to the Executrixces of J. D. Gilreath, deceased so that they may have an instrument to record. It appears that J. D. Gilreath bought the above lot some 40 or 50 years ago but any deed or conveyance made to him was mislaid or lost and has never been recorded and the records of the Sexton of the Springwood Cemetery show that he owns the lot, hence this quitclaim deed by the City.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the grantee S  
hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever
