in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. E. Taylor, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, School District 7-H-1, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 6, of Block A, of a subdivision known as Fair Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 257, and having, according to a recent survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Bleckley avenue at the corner of Lot No. 5, which point is 169.6 feet southwest of the intersection of the Laurens Road and Bleckley avenue, and running thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 5 and 4, S. 30-53 E. 90.1 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 3; thence N. 42-08 W. 83.2 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Bleckley avenue; thence along the southeast side of Bleckley avenue, N. 31-20 E. 18.0 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee is to pay taxes for 1950.
