

security; and other instruments of similar or like nature held by, issued to or registered in the name of Reconstruction Finance Corporation; and certificates or other instruments issued by receivers, trustees, liquidators or other officers or officials, representing claims allowed against or interests in receivership, bankruptcy or other estates; proofs of claim in bankruptcy, receivership or decedents' estates.

To extend and/or consent to the extension of the maturity date or time of payment and otherwise alter or modify the terms of any contract for the sale or lease of real or personal property and of any note, bond and mortgage or other evidence of indebtedness held by Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

5. To accept and/or join with others in the acceptance of resignations of trustees under declarations of trust, trust indentures, deeds of trust and other trust instruments and agreements under which Reconstruction Finance Corporation is the or a beneficiary and/or where Reconstruction Finance Corporation is a holder of any note, notes, bond, bonds, instrument or instruments issued pursuant thereto and/or secured thereby.

To remove and join with others in the removal of any trustee or trustees under any declarations of trust, trust indentures, deeds of trust and other trust instruments and agreements under which Reconstruction Finance Corporation is the or a beneficiary and/or where the Reconstruction Finance Corporation is the holder of any note, notes, bond, bonds, instrument or instruments issued pursuant thereto and/or secured thereby.

To select and designate persons or corporations as original, substitute or successor trustees under declarations of trust, trust indentures, deeds of trust or other trust instruments or agreements under which Reconstruction Finance Corporation is the or a beneficiary and/or where Reconstruction Finance Corporation is the holder of any note, bond or instrument issued pursuant thereto and/or secured thereby and to
