KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Samuel Grady Barton, McKinley Ashmore Barton, and Gary G. Barton.....
 in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and partition of
the estate Dollars -
 to us.....in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
 by Bessie Marie Barton.....
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
 do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie Marie Barton, her heirs and assigns,
 forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, lying on the east side of Middle Tyger River,
 near Liberty Methodist Church, and bounded on the north and west by
 lands of Oma Morrow, formerly T. E. Morrow; on the east by lands of
 Oma Morrow, formerly T. E. Morrow, and also Tract #1 or Gary D.
 Barton; on the south and west by tracts #3, or lands of Samuel Gary
 Barton, by said river and Sam Crane Estate lands, and having the
 following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stone, being the northernmost corner of the tract
 herein conveyed and joint corner with Oma Morrow, and runs thence
 with Oma Morrow lands S 15 E 6.65 chains to a stone; thence N 85-1/2
 E 6.60 chains to a stake in the center of the community road; thence
 with the center of said road as follows: S 13-1/2 W 2.48 chains; S
 45 W 2.94 chains; S 6-1/2 W 1.40 chains; and S 53 E, crossing branch,
 2.20 chains to a stake, corner of Tract #3; thence S 64 W 38.50 chains
 to the middle of South Tyger River (stake on east bank of river);
 thence up said river N 27 E 1.00 chains; thence continuing up said
 river N 1-1/2 W. 7.60 chains to corner of Oma Morrow's lands (stake
 on east bank of river); thence with Morrow's line N 49 E 18.19 chains
 to a stone; thence N 47 E 16.67 chains to the beginning corner,
 containing thirty-eight and 25/100 (38.25) acres, more or less.
