in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Anna Brockman, her heirs and assigns forever:

All our undivided interest in and to:
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, containing 54-3/4 acres, more or less, on waters of Laurel Creek, adjoining lands of John Smith, Peter Benson, Mrs. T. Blakely, et al, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a large stone, corner of Benson and Blakely land and running thence N. 65-1/3 W. 15.08 to a stone xom; thence S. 87-1/3 W. 16.30 to water on Laurel Creek; thence from Laurel Creek about 26.45 to mouth of branch; thence on branch 38.23 to shoal; thence N. 24-1/4 E. 15.89 chains to the beginning stone; said tract of land containing 54-3/4 acres according to plat made by G. A. Ellis May 2, 1917.

ALSO, All that tract of land on branches of Laurel Creek, branches of Roedy River, containing 22-3/4 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone on branch and running thence N. 74 W. 15.67 to a dogwood; thence S. 13-1/4 E. 24.42 to black gum; thence S. 84 E. 3.42 to stake; thence N. 30 E. 6.12 to White Oak at spring; thence down meanders of spring branch to beginning corner, bounded by lands formerly owned by Stevens Griffith, A. Forester, et al.

ALSO, all that other parcel of land containing 11 acres, more or less, lying on Laurel Creek, waters of Roedy River and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone in mouth of ditch on Laurel Creek on the old line of S. Griffith; thence with said line and that of A. Forester, S. 72-1/2 E. 18.00 to stone on branch; thence down branch as a line, N. 23-1/3 W. 16.14 to stake at mouth of branch; thence down Laurel Creek as a line to the beginning corner.

The above two tracts of land contain in the aggregate 90.80 acres according to survey and plat made by W. J. Riddle dated January 17, 1934.
