

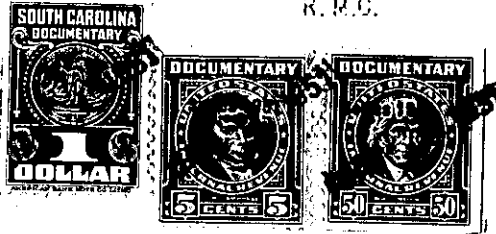

Know All Men by These Presents, That I, Vera Dobbins Tucker

in the State aforesaid, and in consideration of the

 in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
 Shelton J. Rimer, his heirs and assigns,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the branch waters of Pack Creek and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: BEGINNING at an oak tree on the top of Pack's Mountain, it being the corner of Bill Moon, Walk Moon, Joe Belcher and others; thence in a westerly direction along Joe Belcher's line to S. P. Brown; thence along said line to Old Spring Place at Petice Prince line; thence along said line to rock corner; thence in westerly direction to rock corner of M. L. Brown; thence along said line to top of mountain rock corner; thence along top of mountain to the beginning corner, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less. Bounded on the North by Joe Belcher, on the East by A. L. Hightower, on South by A. L. Hightower, on the West by Luther Brown.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being situate in the state and County aforesaid, containing thirteen (13) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of William Moon, Joe Belcher, Andy Adams and others, the same being in Highland Township about one mile from Highland Postoffice.
