

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I Woodrow Smith a legal resident of Greenville state of South Carolina United States of America, and now in the Military service of the United States of America and stationed without the continental limits of the United States, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Lillia Mae Smith of Greenville, South Carolina my true and lawful agent and attorney in fact to act in, manage, and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose for me and in my name place and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself there in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds and things, that is to say;

(1) To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire; to sell, convey, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claims, or otherwise encumber or dispose of; or to contract or agree for the acquisitions, disposal or encumbrance of; any property whatsoever and wheresoever situated, be it real, personal, mixed, or any custody, possession, interest or right therein or pertaining thereto, upon such terms as my said attorney shall think proper;

(2) To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, or let, or otherwise manage any or all of my real, personal, or mixed property, or any interest therein, to object, remove, or relieve tenants or other person from, and protect, preserve, insure, remove, store, transport, repair, rebuild, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof;

(3) To make, do, and transact all and every kind of business of whatever nature or kind whatsoever, including the receipt, recovery, collections payment, compromise, settlement, and adjustment of all accounts, legacies, bequests, interests, dividends, annuities, demands, debts, taxes, and obligation, which may now or hereafter be due, owing, or payable by me or to me;

(4) To make, indorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds, assignments, agreements, certificates, hypothecations, checks, notes, bonds, vouchers, receipts, and other instruments in writing whatsoever kind and nature as may be necessary, convenient, or proper in the premises;

(5) To deposit and withdraw for the purposes hereof, in either my said attorney's name or my name or jointly in both our names, or jointly with any other person or persons, in or from any banking institution, any funds, negotiable papers, or moneys which may come into my said attorney's hands as such attorney or which I now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to;

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority to and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and things whatsoever about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete, and general power herein and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
