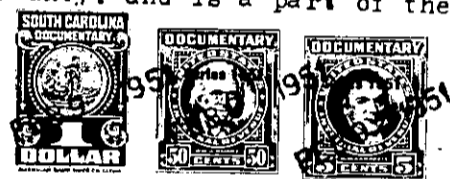

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marie C. Willis and Jake A. Willis, their heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, S. C., about four miles north west of the City of Greer, and lying on the south side of the Buncombe Road (State Highway 414), and being all of lot no. 1 as shown and designated on a plat no. 2 of the property of the G. A. Copeland Estate, plat made by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, and dated Jan. 20, 1951, and having the following courses and distances, to wit; (Said above referred to plat to be recorded in the RMC office for Greenville Co.)

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of said Buncombe Road, joint corner of lots 1 and 2, and running thence S 7-41 W 214.5 feet to a point; thence S 2-53 W 199 feet to a point; thence N 23-45 E 207 feet to a point; thence N 11-45 E 208.7 feet to a point on the south side of said Buncombe Road; thence along the south side of said Buncombe Road, N 80-05 W 95 feet to the point of beginning.
