GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Malcolm C. Ward, of Greenville, South Carolina, do hereby appoint my wife, Margaret G. Ward, my attorney, for me and in my name:

1. To receive and receipt for all moneys due me under Trust Agreement, dated December 5, 1938, of V. B. Ward and Grace K. Ward with the Atlantic National Bank of West Palm Beach, Florida, as trustee thereof, and to exercise full power and control in the management, care, safe-keeping, investment, re-investment and expenditure of the said moneys.

2. To ask for, demand, sue for, recover, receive and receipt for my distributive portion of two thousand five-hundred and twenty-nine (2529) shares of stock in the Globe Oil and Gas Corporation, devised and bequeathed to Vincent S. Ward and Malcolm C. Ward under the last will and testament and codicils thereto of Grace K. Ward, deceased, who died in February, 1950 in the State of Florida.

3. And in addition to the particular powers named hereinabove, to do all other acts, deeds, matters and things whatsoever in or about my estate, property real or personal, and affairs, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in doing all acts, deeds, matters and things, whether or not described hereinabove, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.

It is my specific intent that my said wife, Margaret G. Ward, be empowered and authorized to act on my behalf and in my stead in all matters of whatsoever kind and nature, whether or not particularly described hereinabove, as fully as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.

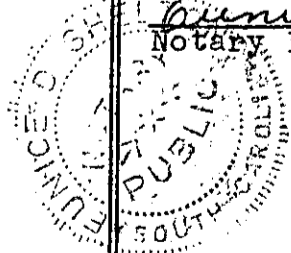
