CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, W. E. CONNOR AND SELMA B. CONNOR
both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 18th. day of April, 1951, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is AUDITORS BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.
- FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to make private investigations of all kinds, make collections, trace missing persons and stolen property, and such other business as is allied with such matters.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable paid in full.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Twenty (20) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 16th. day of April, 1951, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

W. E. Connor and Selma B. Connor

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. E. Connor ; as Vice-President, Selma B. Connor ; as Secretary, Selma B. Connor ; as Treasurer, W. E. Connor

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Connor and Selma B. Connor are duly authorized by the law of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
