Know All Men by These Presents:

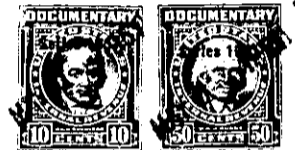
That I, Walton C. Miller, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00) in the State aforesaid, ~~XXXXXX~~

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville Airport Commission,

Lots 50A and 51 as shown on plat of Airport Village Farms made by J. C. Hill September 23, 1948, recorded in Plat Book S, Page 161, from which plat the following description is taken:

BEGINNING At a point on the northern edge of Laurel Creek Road which is the joint corner between Lots 50 and 50A, and running thence with the joint line between these lots 242.95' to their joint rear corner in the line of Lot 71A; thence running the joint line between Lots 50A and 71A in an easterly direction to their joint front corner on Rickenbaker Road, a distance of 50' more or less; thence running the western edge of Rickenbaker Road in a southerly direction 40' to the joint rear corner of Lots 50A and 51; thence running the southern edge of Liaison Avenue along the line of Lot 51 to the joint corner of Lots 51 and 51A, a distance of approximately 50'; thence running the joint line between Lots 51 and 51A, in a southerly direction 245.5' to their joint front corner on the northern edge of Laurel Creek Road; thence running the northern edge of Laurel Creek Road in a northwesterly direction along the front lines of Lots 51 and 50A to the point of beginning, a distance of 105' more or less.

Being the same property conveyed to me by Walter W. Goldsmith, as Trustee, etc., by deed dated March 6, 1951, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 430, Page 240.
