to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. J. McKinney, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 12, of Section 2 of East Highlands Estates, as shown on plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, May 1940, recorded in Plat Book K at Page 44, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Willow Springs Drive, at the joint front corner of lots 9 and 10, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 52-50 W. 148.8 feet to a point in a five foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with said strip, S. 47-43 W. 5 feet to a point; thence continuing with said strip, S. 52-50 W. 114.1 feet to a point on the Southern side of West View Avenue; thence with said Avenue, S. 30-00 W. 60.5 feet to a point, joint corner of lots 10 and 11; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 52-50 E. 232.8 feet to a point on the North side of Willow Springs Drive; thence with said Drive, N. 56-50 E. 69 feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

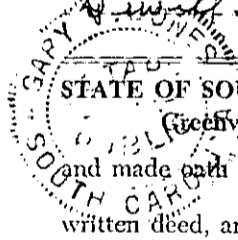
