CHARTER

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, J. W. OUZTS AND C. A. SHEFFIELD

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 18th. day of June, 1951, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is FALMETTO ENTERPRISES, INC. OF GREENVILLE, S. C.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is buy, sell, rent, lease, manage, mortgage, improve or otherwise deal in real estate; to build, construct, remodel, repair, plan or otherwise deal in buildings of every kind and nature; to invest in, buy, sell and otherwise deal in stocks, bonds and securities, and to do any and all other acts authorized by business corporation under the laws of the State of South Carolina.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00), - - - - - Dollars payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Thousand (1,000) of the par value of One (\$1.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 12th. day of June, 1951, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

J. W. Ouzts, C. A. Sheffield, and Terrance Carr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. W. Ouzts; as Vice-President, Terrance Carr; as Secretary, C. A. Sheffield; as Treasurer, C. A. Sheffield

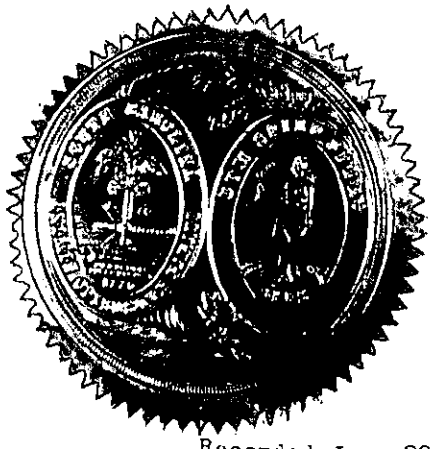
NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the foregoing has been done in accordance with the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written Declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that copies of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Means Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
