Love and affection to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gladys S. Williams, her heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Paris Mountain Avenue and Beacon Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as lot No. 7 on a revised plat of property of B. E. Geer, made by W. M. Rast, Engineer, February, 1929, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book H, page 142, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Paris Mountain Avenue and Beacon Street and running thence along the West side of Beacon Street N. 5-50 W. 154.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 1 S. 83-55 W. 66 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 8 S. 5-50 E. 154.7 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Paris Mountain Avenue; thence with the North side of Paris Mountain Avenue N. 84-02 E. 66 feet to the point of beginning.

By acceptance of this deed, the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay that certain mortgage executed by W. James Williams to C. Douglas Wilson and Company in the original principal sum of \$7700.00, said mortgage being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Mortgages Volume 353, page 290.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
