

in cash upon the execution of this contract and the balance of five hundred and no/100 dollars (\$500.00) when the purchaser begins cutting and removing said timber.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the purchaser shall have a period of six (6) months from and after the execution of this contract in which to cut and remove said timber from said premises.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the purchaser shall have the right to such rights of way as shall be reasonably necessary in order to remove said timber from said premises and shall not be responsible for any damage occasioned to said premises by the cutting or removal of said timber.
