Know All Men by These Presents:

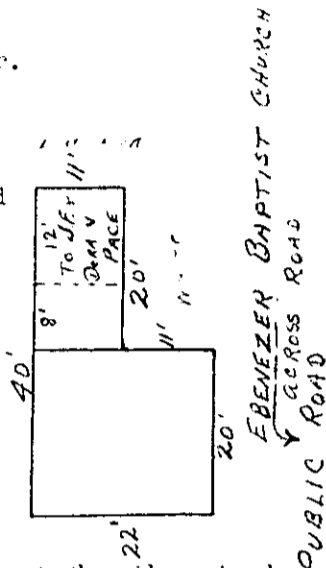
That I, T. E. Coleman, Jr., Trustee, in the State aforesaid,
