did on the 5th. day of March, 1952, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is

NATIONAL CONTAINER CORPORATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To produce, manufacture, market, prepare for market, design, alter, repair, transport, import, purchase, exchange, hire, or otherwise acquire, and to export, sell, mortgage, pledge, trade in or otherwise dispose of, and deal in and with containers and boxes of all kinds and any and all parts thereof and supplies therefor and materials used in connection therewith and all kinds of fiber and fiber products, paper and paper products and cardboard and cardboard products.

To purchase, contract for, build, acquire, hold, own, operate, maintain, equip, mortgage, pledge, lease, sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of real estate, buildings, warehouses, mills, factories, plants, shops and other structures, machinery, equipment and businesses, and to purchase, contract for, hold, own, mortgage, pledge, lease, sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of goods, wares, merchandise and property of every kind and description, and to carry on any of the above businesses or any other business connected therewith, or helpful in the conduct of any of said businesses, wherever the same may be permitted by law, and to the full extent as the laws of the State of South Carolina will permit and as fully and will all the power that the laws of the State of South Carolina confer upon corporations.

To make, manufacture, produce, purchase, or otherwise acquire, to hold, own, sell and otherwise deal in, either directly or indirectly, pulp and paper of all kinds, and any ingredients employed in the production thereof, and any products thereof and articles manufactured therefrom, and any kindred or other merchandise and articles of manufacture.

To conduct logging operations and operate mills for the manufacture of lumber and products thereof; to acquire, erect, maintain and operate mill privileges, water rights, mills and other structures, with their machinery, equipment and appliances; and for its own use to develop, generate, purchase, lease, exchange and otherwise deal in water power and/or electric power, and in that behalf to construct, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to lease, exchange and otherwise deal in, water rights, water sheds, power sites, dams, plants and structures of any kind or nature.

To establish and maintain any laboratories or experimental plants for inventing, manufacturing or producing any and all kinds whatsoever of new industrial products and processes, and also machines, tools, appliances and equipment.

To build, construct, purchase, contract for or otherwise acquire, own, lease and control from time to time one or more vessels, ships, boats, dredges, barges, tugs, lighters, sailing and all water craft or interest therein; to charter, hire, operate, equip, loan on commission, or otherwise use, repair, let out on hire and trade with the same; to carry on the business of a ship-owner with respect to said vessels, ships, boats, dredges, barges, tugs, lighters, sailing and all water craft or interest therein; to purchase, own, construct, control and operate, lease, acquire and hold such buildings, warehouses, drydocks and dock machinery, wharves, piers, elevators, landings and easements as may be advantageous for carrying on a shipping business; and to cooperate the same for the transportation of freight of all kinds with power to purchase, build, construct, repair, lease, sell and convey, all machinery, appliances and apparatus incidentally necessary thereto with power to do a towing business and a general shipbuilding, stevedore, dockage, warehouse and commission business, and to engage in export and import trade; to load and unload ships, cars, lighters and barges, and to store freight and materials of all kinds.
