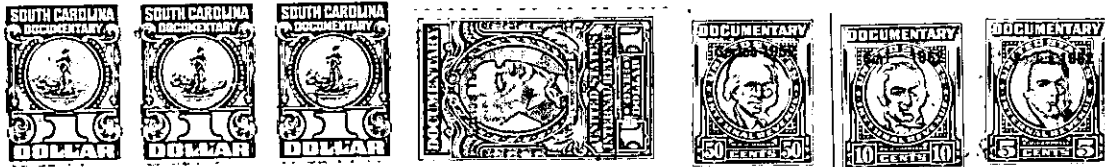
Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, William C. Glenn and Margaret M. Glenn in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred (\$1400.00) DOLLARS, Richard N. Bright and Elizabeth G. Bright to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Richard N. Bright and Elizabeth G. Bright and their heirs and assigns:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the North side of Vandeventer Drive in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 14 of the Property of Margaret M. Green according to survey and plat by H.S. Prockman, Surveyor, dated February 24, 1942, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Vandeventer Drive, corner of lot conveyed to Richard N. and Elizabeth G. Bright by Margaret M. Green, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 0.17 W. 168.6 feet to iron pin on the Finley line; thence with the Finley line, S. 79.40 E. 96 feet to iron pin; thence S. 2.45 W. 152.5 to the edge of Vandeventer Drive; thence with same, N. 89.23 W. 86.3 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to William C. Glenn and Margaret M. Glenn by deed of Margaret M. Green, recorded in Deed Book 405, page 75, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
