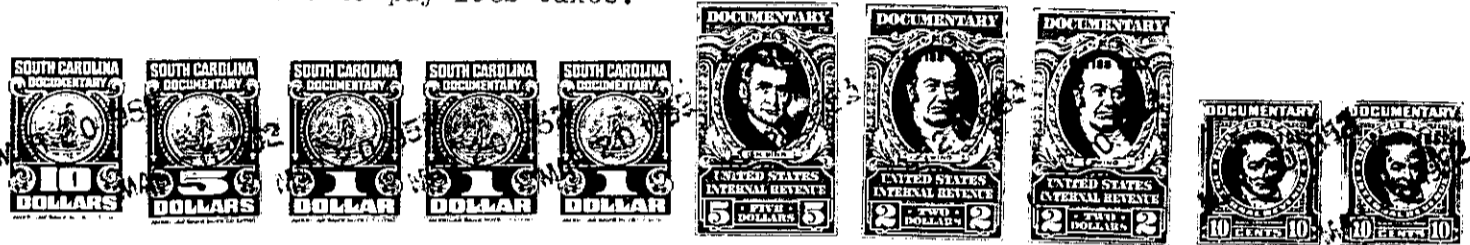

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Parke L. Barron and Florence E. Barron, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the South side of North Estate Drive near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 50 on plat of Crestwood, Inc., made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, February 28, 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in plat book S, at page 189, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of North Estate Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 49 and 50, and running thence with the line of Lot 49, S. 47-00 W. 120.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-15 W. 106.1 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of North Estate Drive; thence with the Southeast side of North Estate Drive, N. 49-40 E. 35 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of North Estate Drive; thence with the South side of North Estate Drive, N. 79-05 E. 50 feet to an iron pin on the South side of North Estate Drive; thence with the Southwest side of North Estate Drive, S. 74-10 E. 50 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of North Estate Drive; thence with the Southwest side of North Estate Drive, S. 52-05 E. 35 feet to the beginning corner.
